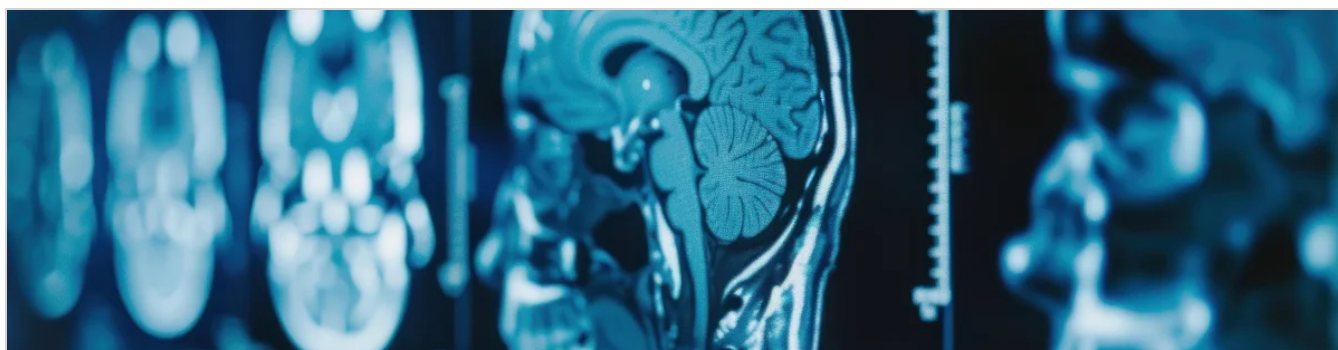


AFTER A CAR ACCIDENT, FALL, OR BLOW TO THE HEAD

INITIAL EVALUATION

Brief check ins between visits show how symptoms change, supported by the **Kavera** platform.

GUIDELINE INFORMED PLAN

Recommendations follow recognized concussion management guidelines, not guesswork.

ORGANIZED RECORDS

Every assessment becomes a clear written record for your providers, work or school, and your attorney.
